Weather, family, classroom objects, places around the town.



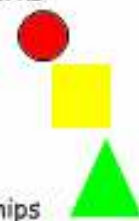
## PSHE (Personal Social Health Education)

Saxons: Roald Dahl



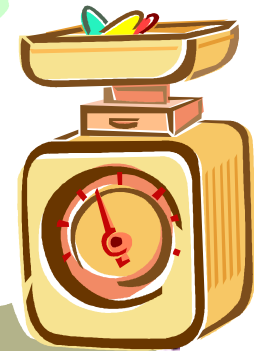
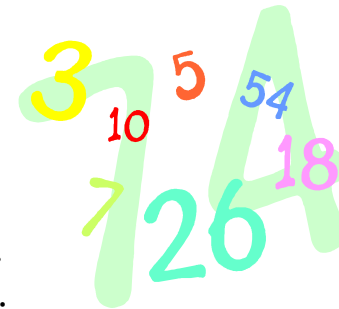
### Numeracy
