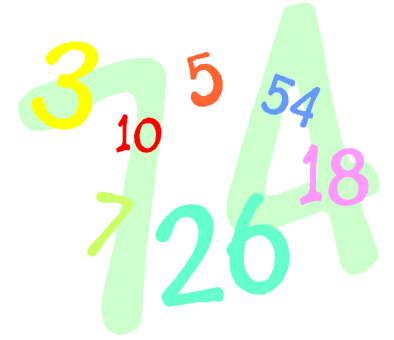
### Literacy

Continue to reinforce work on time, money and multiplication tables.

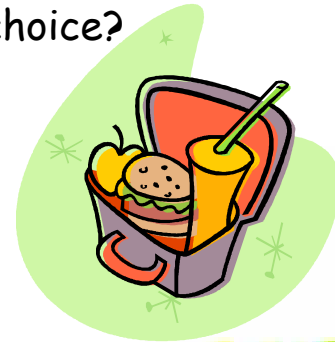
Bake a cake, measuring the ingredients yourself. Look for things that use measuring scales.

### Science

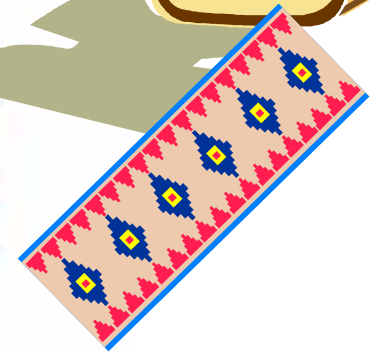
Keep a healthy food diary. How healthy are you?
